of the Dead are not related. The Day of the Dead begins at 11:59 on November 1st but really happens on November 2nd. The Day of the Dead is a celebration of life and mocking death, but also remembering the dead's memories. Halloween on the other hand is a celebration of our fear of the dead and the unknown. The Day of the Dead originates from South American traditions, such as the Aztecs' Quecholli, a celebration which honored Mixcōatl, the Aztec god of war. On the other hand, Halloween originates from Christianity. All Hallows' Eve, or Halloween is one of three days included in Allhallowtide. The other two are All Saints' Day (or All Hallows' Day) on November 1st, and All Souls' Day on November 2nd. These 3 days celebrate the saints, and the souls who departed for but have yet to reach heaven. It is possible
