

artistry brushes. Another commonly thought-of product from sheep is their meat. This is used for human consumption in multiple food products.

However, sheep produce much more than that. The hide of a sheep can be used to make leather, and all of the products that you can make from leather. The intestines of a sheep once cleaned can be used as bouncy springs, like the kinds used in tennis rackets. They can also be used as sausage casings, or instrument strings. Sheep manure can be used as fertilizer for soil, as it contains potash, phosphorus and many minor minerals. The blood of a dead sheep is often used for culturing bacteria for scientific uses, or industrial uses like making certain cheeses. Sheep produce milk too, just like cows. While the milk might not be as pleasant to drink as a cow's milk, it is great for making cheeses. The fat from a sheep is used in explosives, solvents, paints and chewing gum! A final product can be extracted from the sheep. In order to rid the wool of any debris it might have obtained, processors put the wool in a centrifuge to purify it. One thing that comes out is lanolin. Lanolin can be used for tape, motor oils, lubrication, cosmetics, lipstick, pharmaceuticals, lotion, mascara, shampoo and conditioner.




